	<p><u>The Police and Online Learning</u> This week, the police visited Owl class to talk to them about online safety, bullying online and how to keep themselves safe. The children were very honest about their use of the internet and social media, asked lots of great questions and went away with lots of tips on how to use digital technologies safely. There are some useful links and advice for parents later in this bulletin.</p>
	<p><u>Walk to School Week</u> This nationwide event is organised by walking charity Living Streets. This year's challenge, The Magic of Walking, encourages children to travel actively to school every day of the week. Each pupil will be challenged to travel sustainably (walk, wheel, scoot, cycle or Park and Stride) to school every day</p>

for one week using the wallchart and stickers to log their journeys. If possible, we are asking families to walk, scoot etc. to school the week commencing 20th May. If you live far away from school or it is not safe to walk in from where you live we have secured the use of the village hall carpark (Cackle Street) between 8.30am and 9.15am that week to provide parking to enable families to safely walk to school from there. Each class will work collectively to make as many active journeys to school as possible across the week. Individual activity diaries, daily stickers will awarded to the children taking part.

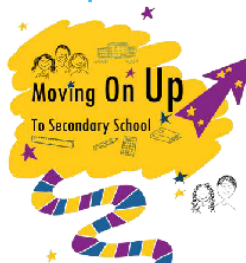
**CLASS & CLASS+


