Next Week is Walk to School Week

This nationwide event is organised by walking charity Living Streets. This year's challenge, The Magic of Walking, encourages children to travel actively to school every day of the week. Each pupil will be challenged to travel sustainably (walk, wheel, scoot, cycle or Park and Stride) to school every day for one week using the wallchart and stickers to log their journeys. If you live far away from school or it is not safe to walk in from where you live we have secured the use of the village hall carpark (Cackle Street) between 8.30am and 9.15am that week to provide parking to enable families to safely walk to school from there. Each class will work collectively to make as many active journeys to school as possible across the week. Individual activity diaries, daily stickers will awarded to the children taking part.



The Bright Foundation: Costume and Character

Foxes Class had a fantastic fun and interactive day at the Bright Foundation this week, taking part in activities inspired by iconic costumes from the Cosprop collection.

They explored what **costume** means - from dance, theatre, and film productions to folk activities and religious ceremonies, identifying costumes and places and period of history they came from. Year 6 to Year 7, Parent Transition Workshop

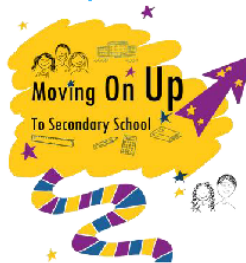
CLASS & CLASS+ Parent Transition Workshop


