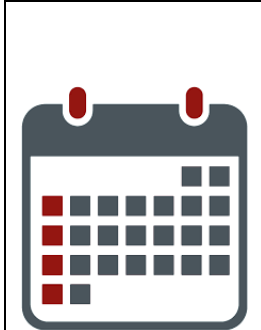
Parent Governor
