Hedgehogs: **Ren F** for always being so kind and helpful to both children and adults. You are an excellent role-model!

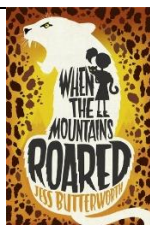


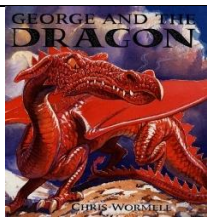
### Readers of the Year

Year 6 children may also bring in an old school shirt for signing if they wish. No other children may have their shirts written on – this is a Year 6 privilege!



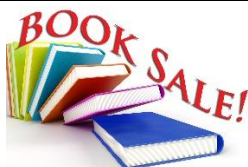
### Quad Athletics
