	<p><b>Safety in Action – Year 6</b>            On Tuesday this week, Year 6 took part in 'Safety in Action.' An event, which encourages children to recognise hazards and take action to keep themselves and others safe. The project is coordinated by East Sussex Fire and Rescue Service, working with other emergency services and other agencies. The children took part in simulated scenarios that allowed them to think about safe responses to a variety of different situations. The project is aimed at year 6 children (age 10 and 11 years) – before they make the step to secondary school and greater independence.</p>
