

## English/Phonics

This term we will be learning to leave spaces between words, begin to use capital letters and full stops in our writing. We will also be learning to recite poetry and write our own riddle.

We will also be rehearsing all the sounds we have previously learnt and learn to blend longer words

## Science

We will be learning to identify and name some common animals, to identify, name and sort animals that are herbivores, carnivores and omnivores. We will learn to name, identify and label the parts of the human body. We will be learning about the season of Autumn

## Maths

This term we will learning to write numbers to 10 correctly, count backwards and find 1 more and 1 less. We will compare groups and numbers of objects and order numbers. We will learn to use a number line and we will learn number bonds within ten. We will being to learn basic addition and subtraction.

## P.E

We will be having weekly P.E sessions with our specialist PE teacher to help develop our agility, balance and co-ordination. This term our focus is dance and movement.

## Humanities

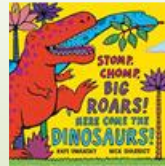
This term our focus is Geography. We will learn we we live and find where we live on a map. We will learn whre our school is and understand the route we take to school.

Home learning - I will be sending out termly home learning to support what children are doing in school.

Outdoor Clothing - Children will need wellies in school to take part in our outdoor learning sessions when it gets muddy.

Reading - Children in Reception will initially be given a book with no words to tell their own stories. Once children are able to recognise sounds and blend they will be given a decodable book to practise with at home. Once a child is fluent with the book they will be given a new one. Children will also be able to select a book from the class library each week to share with parents.
