This half term, we'll find out about how food is grown, transported and sold from around the world. We'll take a look at food packaging and adverts and discuss how they are designed, made and who they are targeted towards. We will then design our own food packaging box and advert to try and persuade people to buy our food product. In Geography, we'll look at where our food comes from and focus on one particular ingredient and explore how it is produced, transported and the effect this has on the environment. We'll use maps and atlases to learn about foods from around the world and locate where different ingredients come from.

We shall read about an incredible book eating boy and write our own humorous story based on that book. Our science work will focus on animals and exploring their different habitats as well as investigating diverse food chains. In maths, we will examine the relationship between multiplying and dividing and develop different techniques to solve these problems. We shall also develop control of our bodies as we use different movements to express ourselves through dance for our PE. We will also begin to be able to talk about ourselves and the things around us as we learn some more French vocab.

Help your child prepare for their project

This is a perfect opportunity to taste new foods and have a go at following recipes. Why not bake healthy muffins or prepare a slow cooker stew together? You could also sample adventurous foods from around the world. Alternatively, you could look at the designs and read the packaging of foods in your fridge to find out where they have come from.
